## STEP #9 - INSTALL DOOR GUIDES

- INSTALL HEADSTOPS AS SHOWN IN DIAGRAM 20 ON EACH GUIDE USING THE 5/16" -18 x 1" BOLTS (28), 5/16" LOCK WASHERS (30), 5/16" FLAT WASHERS (31) AND 5/16" - 18 NUTS (29) PROVIDED.
- THE HEAD STOPS ON THE GUIDES SHOULD BE NO MORE THAN 1" HIGHER (TO BOTTOM OF STOPS) THAN THE DOOR HEADER. IF NOT, CUT THE BOTTOM OF THE GUIDES TO MATCH YOUR OPENING HEIGHT AND RELOCATE SLIDE BOLT NOTCH AT BOTTOM OF THE GUIDE
- RAISE THE DOOR CURTAIN SO THE BOTTOM ANGLE IS APPROXIMATELY 3". 76.2mm BELOW THE HEADER. SLIDE THE GUIDE OVER THE DOOR CURTAIN AND POSITION AGAINST THE DOOR OPENING ALLOWING 3/8" / 9.5mm CLEARANCE FROM THE EDGE OF THE CURTAIN TO INSIDE THE GUIDE.

- SPRAY SILICONE LUBRICANT IN THE GUIDES FOR EASE OF OPERATION.

DOORS ORDERED FOR CONCRETE/MASONRY APPLICATIONS WILL INCLUDE 1/4"x1-3/4" TAPCONS (84) FOR GUIDE INSTALLATION. BLOCK CLIPS WELDED TO THE BACK OF GUIDE FOR CONCRETE/MASONRY APPLICATION ARE OPTIONAL

## STEP #10 - CHECK AND ADJUST BALANCE

IF DOOR LOWERS EASILY AND RAISES HARD, MORE TENSION IS REQUIRED IF THE DOOR LOWERS HARD AND RAISES EASILY, LESS TENSION IS REQUIRED. (SEE DIAGRAM 18)

CAUTION: FOR ALL DOOR DRIVES: BEFORE ADJUSTING THE SPRINGS. PULL THE DOORS INTO THE UP POSITION. SECURE THE DOOR BY THE FOLLOWING METHODS:


- TIE ROPE AROUND THE DOOR ROLL.
- PLACE A CLAMP AT THE TOP OF THE GUIDE CHANNEL TO SECURE THE CURTAIN IN THE GUIDES



- RAISE DOOR 2'-6" / 762mm FROM FLOOR, OR UNTIL MARK IS ACCESSIBLE. PLACE TOP DRAFT STOP IN POSITION A SHOWN AND SECURE WITH TEK SCREWS STRETCH RUBBER SLIGHTLY AND SECURE OTHER END LOCATE AND INSTALL THE REMAINDER OF TEK SCREWS AT 12" / 304.8mm O.C.



## STEP #12 - INSTALL JAMB BRUSH SEAL



A. INSERT BRUSH INTO RETAINER. LINE UP RETAINERS ALONG JAMB SO THAT BRUSH SEAL FILLS THE DOOR CORRUGATION WHEN DOOR IS IN THE CLOSED POSITION. ATTACH RETAINER TO JAMB USING APPROPRIATE FASTENERS AT 6" / 152.4mm FROM FLOOR AND HEADER AND 24" / 609.6mm CENTER MINIMUM






## STEP #2 - INSTALL SUPPORT BRACKETS

- MARK THE HORIZONTAL ANGLE POSITION OF THE SUPPORT BRACKETS.

#### DRIVE SIDE FOR POCKET WHEEL REDUCTION DRIVE CHAIN HOIST AND E.O. KITS .:


- PLACE THE AXLE CLAMP (44) ONTO HORIZONTAL MEMBER OF THE SUPPORT BRACKET (36-43) AND UNDER THE DOOR AXLE.
- PLACE AXLE CLAMP (44) AND STANDARD KEEPER PLATE (45) ON TOP OF THE DOOR AXLE AS SHOWN.
- FASTEN AXLE CLAMPS AND STANDARD KEEPER PLATE TOGETHER USING 3/8"x3-1/2" HEX BOLTS (46), 3/8" LOCK WASHERS (49), 3/8" FLAT WASHERS (48), AND 3/8" NUTS (FINE THREAD) (47)---TIGHTEN SECURELY.

## NOTE:

- REQUIRES A MINIMUM OF 40 ft-lb / 54.23 Nm TORQUE TO PROPERLY SECURE HARDWARE
- EXTENDED KEEPER PLATE ONLY FOR DOORS SIZES 16' / 4.8m x16' / 4.8m & LARGER

#### NON-DRIVE SIDE FOR POCKET WHEEL REDUCTION DRIVE CHAIN HOIST AND E.O. KITS:


- PLACE THE AXLE CLAMP (44) ONTO HORIZONTAL MEMBER OF THE SUPPORT BRACKET (36-43) AND UNDER THE DOOR AXLE.
- PLACE AXLE CLAMP (44) AND EXTENDED KEEPER PLATE (50) ON TOP OF THE DOOR AXLE AS SHOWN.
- FASTEN AXLE CLAMPS USING 3/8"x3-1/2" HEX BOLTS (46) 3/8" NUTS (FINE THREAD) (46), 3/8" FLAT WASHERS (48), 3/8" LOCK WASHERS (49) TO ATTACH EXTENDED KEEPER PLATE AS SHOWN. TIGHTEN SECURELY.
- LOCATE AXLE HARDWARE AS SHOWN FOR FINAL POSITION. (SEE DIAGRAM 16)



- 1. DIMENSIONS ARE APPROXIMATE POSITION FOR OPTIMAL PERFORMANCE. ADJUST AS NEEDED.
- TO SPIN DOOR FOR PRETENSIONING SPRINGS, MIGHT REQUIRE MOVING THE DOOR AWAY FROM THE WALL TO ALLOW BOTTOM BAR TO PASS. IF SO, LOOSEN HARDWARE ONE SIDE AT A TIME & SLIDE DOOR AXLE TOWARD WALL TO ITS BEST POSITION. BE CAREFUL DOOR WILL BE UNDER TENSION.

## STEP #6 - PRE-TENSION SPRINGS

- A. INSTALL CHAIN CLIP (79) APPROXIMATELY 4'-0" ABOVE FLOOR ON CHAIN OPERATED DOORS. INSTALLATION MUST BE SECURE
- APPLY PRE-TENSION TO THE SPRINGS BY ROTATING THE DOOR TWO (2) TURNS IN A FORWARD DIRECTION (SEE DIAGRAM 17). THE BOTTOM ANGLI IS TO BE IN A 6 O'CLOCK POSITION.



- C. IF YOU'RE UNABLE TO ROTATE DOOR TO PRE-TENSION, USE A PIPE WRENCH TO ROTATE AXLE IN OPPOSITE DIRECTION. WITH ONE PERSON ON EACH SIDE OF DOOR, EACH PERSON SHOULD FIRMLY PLACE A LARGE PIPE WRENCH ON THE DOOR AXLE (SEE DIAGRAM 18). PULL DOWN TO APPLY TENSION INCREMENTALLY UNTIL YOU ACHIEVE TWO FULL ROTATIONS OF THE DOOR AXLE. THEN TIGHTEN THE AXLE HARDWARE.
- D. REPEAT STEP "C" IF ADJUSTMENT IS NECESSARY.

## STEP #7 -REMOVE PLASTIC WRAPPING


- TAKE HOLD OF THE DOOR BY THE BOTTOM ANGLE AND REMOVE THE OUTER WRAPPING AND TAPE THAT HOLDS THE DOOR IN A ROLL.
- CAREFULLY LOWER THE DOOR DOWN AND SECURE THE DOOR APPROXIMATELY 4' FROM THE FLOOR TO PREVENT UPWARD TRAVEL USING CLAMPS OR HOOK HAND CHAIN IF A CHAIN HOIST DOOR.

## STEP #8 - INSTALL DOOR STOPS (LIFT CLIPS) AND SLIDE BOLT LOCKS

- A. INSTALL THE DOOR STOPS (53) AND THE SLIDE BOLT LOCKS (54) USING 1/4"x1-1/4" CARRIAGE BOLT (55), 1/4" FLAT WASHER (58), 5/16" NÚT (57), AND 1/4" SELF LOCKING NUT (56) PER SIDE.
- ELECTRONICALLY OPERATED DOORS STILL REQUIRE DOOR STOPS A (LIFT CLIPS) TO BE INSTALLED.
- WINDLOCK "CERTIFIED" DOORS REQUIRE SLIDE BOLT LOCKS TO BE INSTALLED FOR PROPER WINDLOAD PROTECTION. ELECTRICAL INTERLOCKS ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

#### NOTE:

WHEN INSTALLING SLIDE BOLT LOCKS THE THREADS FROM THE CARRIAGE HEAD BOLTS PROTRUDING FROM THE SELF LOCKING NUT SHOULD BE REMOVED TO A FLUSH POSITION WITH SELF LOCKING NUT TO PREVENT DOOR FROM HANGING UP ON THE HEAD STOPS. CLAMP A PAIR OF VICE GRIPS ON TO THE THREAD AND BREAK OFF, IF NECESSARY,



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
